Hello Christus Victor Family and Friends,

There are about to be some changes around here and they are not the kind of changes that make us all uncomfortable. This week, Tebertha (our school director), Shon (assistant director) and I put our heads together to consider how we might move the preschool class over to the family life center. This has been a conversation that we have had for the last several years. As we consider the possibility of taking up part of the "gym" to create a new classroom, we became a bit overwhelmed with the cost and the logistics of doing that. There are plans to take care of the cost, but what do we do with the children while construction was going on? While come school/daycare facilities close down for the summer like the school district, ours is year-round. All of that became a bit overwhelming for all of us. BUT...... We kept working on it.

I will not bore you with all the details however, within the next week or two, we will be rearranging some rooms in the family life center, taking Tebertha's private office away (her choice not mine) and play fruit basket upset with some of the children and move the preschool class to the Family Life Center.

This is good for the school in many ways. It gives the preschool class more oversight by Tebertha and Shon. While this is a very well-run class (thanks Mrs. Teresa), there are times when extra help is needed. With them in the church building, it is hard for Mrs. Teresa to get that help at times.

The concern about security for the 4-year-old class comes up every year with someone wanting the same sort of key pad entry system as the Family Life Center has. That is not feasible considering the number of individuals from our church that come in at varied times, as well as for the deliveries and the list goes on. Bottom line is that this is a very good thing for the school program.

That means that the church will have full use of the entire Church building at all times. Now is the time for us to dream and consider what God may be calling us to. That room can be used for weekday Bible studies, or daytime quilting or other projects. It can be used for meetings and gatherings. Most of all it can be used for ministry to our community. We have talked about several things over the last few years. Now is the time to jump in with both feet.

Once the move has happened, I will find a date that all who want to help consider what this ministry may be to gather and dream and PLAN.

I am excited about what this will mean for Christus Victor Lutheran Church. I am excited to really consider what God is calling us to. I am excited to see how the Spirit of God moves through the people of this congregation to serve the community we are in and beyond.

I pray this stirs a bit of excitement in you as well and that you will start thinking, not just of what we might be able to do, but also what it will take for us to get started. Be looking forward to the announcement of the meeting. I am so excited!
