
Ash Wednesday Service

Hello Christus Victor Family and friends...

We have barely finished Christmas and Epiphany and we are staring in the face of Lent. This year Easter is the earliest that it can ever be: March 31st. Needless to say, with having another church begin to worship in our facilities it feels like we have had little time to think about Lent. But never fear, We are ready......

Ash Wednesday falls on Valentines day this year. We will have a service with the imposition of Ashes on February 14, 2023 at 7:00 pm.

Lenten Soup Suppers and worship will begin with supper at 5:45 p.m. and Holden Evening prayer at 7:00 p.m. on the following Wednesdays: February 21st & 28th, March 6th, 13th, & 20th.

Maundy Thursday service will be on March 28th at 7:00 p.m.

Good Friday service will be on March 29th at 7:00 p.m.

Christus Victor and Faith Lutheran will be doing the mid-week services together throughout this season. The midweek liturgy will be Holden Evening prayer and the time for a message will be something we used several years ago.

We will be using "THE PEOPLE VS. JUDUS ISCARIOT". For those who may not have been here or for our brothers and sisters from Faith, this is the penalty phase of Judas' trial for having betrayed Jesus. Each week you will see and hear from THE JUDGE, THE BALIFF, THE DEFENSE ATTORNEY (GRACE), & THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY (JUSTICE). JUDAS will be present throughout the trial, but he says very little.

Each week one or two witnesses are questioned in order to convince the jury that Judas deserves death or that he deserves mercy. The prosecution will bring forth John the Disciple, Mary Magdalene, Unnamed Woman, Disciple Peter, the Young Boy, and Mary the mother of Jesus.

The Defense will bring forth a Friend of Judas, the Chief Priest, the Apostle Paul and finally, Death personified. In the end, you; all who have come to witness this trial, will be the one casting a ballot for the verdict. Both sides have very good points made and it is up to you what will happen next.

The last time we did this it made a big impact on the people who attended. It is a drama that makes you think very carefully about our understanding of Grace, Justice and Mercy. If you have never attended a mid-week Lenten service, this is one to try. Come and enjoy some of the best soup around and get to know one another and then stick around for the trial. I promise you won't be disappointed!
